
Hello friends.

Pastor Jim and Ralph invited their new friends to join them for a special picnic. 26 Deaf people came and heard a very simple truth that God loves them and desires a personal relationship with them. They shared a meal together and played a couple of games. They also gave them scripture bracelets and homemade bookmarks that Debbie Walterhouse had made for them that said "God loves you" in their native language. They look forward to returning in the fall, Lord willing. Gospel seeds were planted, and we pray God will continue to draw them to Himself.





CUBA
